ELIGIBLE ITEMS - HONEY

HONEY IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE SFMNP PROGRAM

Honey must be pure, unprocessed and locally produced. Allowable forms of honey include the following:

Comb Honey – honey that comes exactly as it was produced in the hive

Cut Comb Honey – liquid honey that may have added chunks of the honey in the jar

Liquid Honey – honey that is 100 percent pure, is free of visible crystals and has been extracted directly from the honeycomb

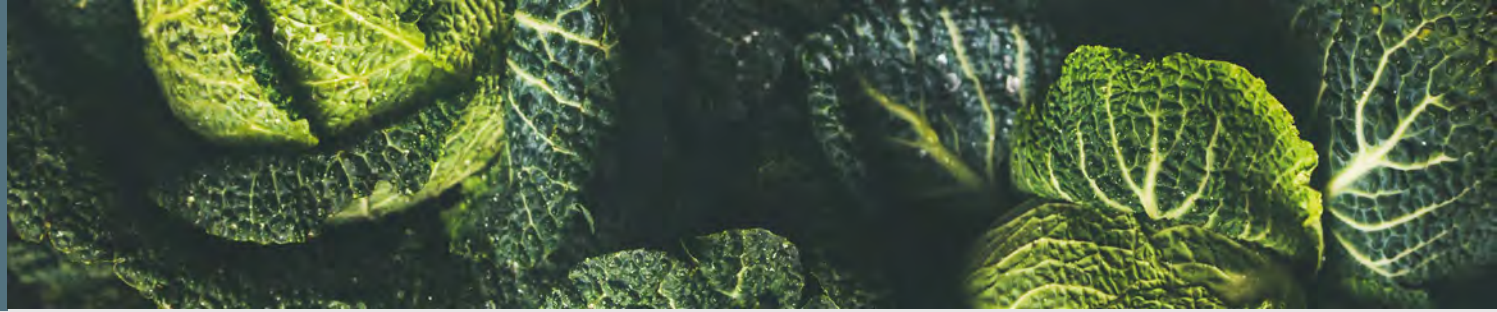
